



Match Day - FAQs

1. Can Photos / videos be taken of children?

Yes, if parental consent exists and the purpose of the image is understood.

Parents may photograph their own children.

Match-Day Co-ordinator may seek confirmation with those taking photos/video, to ensure that this policy is being adhered to.

2. Photos of the Scoresheet?

Yes, only for your own team's side

Photos should not include names or identifying details of players from the opposing team.

3. Male Participation

13U and Primary divisions: No restrictions applied based on gender. Males must be aged less than 13 years (actual age) as at the first day of competition.

18U and Open: a maximum of 1 male on court at any one time, in any third and any position.

4. Uniform

Undergarments are permitted, must be all black, all white or the predominate club colour, and clubs should manage consistency within and across teams.

Additional clothing options are permitted for religious, cultural, medical or other inclusive reasons. They must be safe and align with colour guidelines per undergarments.

Jewellery & body piercings including taped jewellery, **must not be worn** during winter competition.

Only exceptions: Open division for taped wedding bands, medical exemption arranged prior with admin@cvna.com.au, and held for presentation to umpires.

5. Scoring

First named team scores on the scoresheet, the second on the live scoring device – unless both scorers agree to switch prior to the game starting.

Home team returns scoresheet to the office. The Scoresheet is the authoritative record.

If the scorer/club/team believes the score is incorrect, lodge a dispute with admin@cvna.com.au within 72 hours of the game being played.



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6. Major Injury / Incident

Club / team must provide their own first aid kit, and have a Primary Carer, provide a Netball Victoria Injury Report form if required.

In an emergency dial **000**.

Refer to the emergency procedure plan in the office.
