Objective of Role:	The Squad Coach is responsible for leading the development, preparation, and performance of an allocated Representative Squad Team. This includes planning and conducting regular training sessions, coaching the team through regional tournaments and the North Central Zone Association Championships, and fostering a positive, inclusive, and growth-focused environment. The role contributes to strengthening the reputation of the Association through exacting standards of coaching, conduct and player experience, while ensuring all players receive fair opportunities for development and court time.
Key Duties:	<p>The key duties of this role include, but are not limited to:</p> <p>Training & Player Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plan and deliver regular, structured training sessions that develop individual and team skills.• Provide coaching that aligns with CVNA values, player development principles, and representative program goals.• Enhance the technical, tactical, and physical skills of all players in the squad.• Give constructive feedback to support player growth and confidence. <p>Tournament & Championship Leadership</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Coach and manage the team throughout designated regional tournaments.• Lead the team through the North Central Zone Association Championships, ensuring preparedness and professionalism.• Ensure all players receive a minimum of 20% court time in each tournament, in line with CVNA policy. <p>Team Culture & Experience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create a positive, inclusive, and supportive team environment for players, parents, and support personnel.• Promote behaviours that reflect CVNA's reputation and uphold high standards of sportsmanship.• Communicate openly with players, parents and Association personnel regarding schedules, expectations, and team progress. <p>Representation & Conduct</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Represent the Association with professionalism at all tournaments, events, and interactions.



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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Contribute to building the Association's reputation through strong coaching standards, respectful conduct, and player welfare. <p>Administration & Coordination</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Work collaboratively with the Rep Squad Coordinator, Team Manager and volunteers to ensure smooth team operations.Attend required coach briefings, meetings, and development sessions.Submit required documentation, team lists, and reports in a timely manner.

Funds & Equipment	<p>This role has no authority to spend or commit Association funds without prior approval of the Board.</p> <p>The Association will provide all necessary equipment for this role. All equipment will remain the property of the Association and will be returned in good order, acknowledging fair wear and tear, upon completion or termination of this engagement.</p>
Termination	<p>Either party can terminate this engagement with 2 weeks written notice.</p> <p>Either party can terminate this engagement with immediate effect in the event of a breach of the terms of this engagement, including a breach of the CVNA policies or Victorian Child Safety Standards.</p>
Confidentiality	<p>In your role you will have access to personal information on players and their families. This information is to be held in the strictest confidence and not released to any other party without prior approval of the Association Board.</p>
